The membership of the Society's Law Enforcement Division shall consist of active members only. Burlington County SPCA general members may apply for admittance into the Law Enforcement Division.

The names of all applicants for Law Enforcement Division membership shall be referred to the Chiefs Office for processing. Applications shall be reviewed by the Chief or his designee and processed as needed. All other applications will be held on file until such time as an opening arises. Law Enforcement Division Membership is a privilege, not a right and as such the Chief reserves the right to deny membership based on findings of a thorough and complete background check.

Law Enforcement Division applicants shall be subject to a full and complete background investigation. All reasons for non acceptance shall be disclosed at the completion of the application process. Simply submitting an application for membership to the Law Enforcement Division does not guarantee admittance. Successful applicants will be notified of their admittance into the Law Enforcement Division and a conditional offer of employment shall be tendered. Training will occur at a date to be determined by the Chief.

Any Humane Law Enforcement Officer, Agent or member, may be removed from the Law Enforcement Division for cause, which shall be deemed to be any material digression from the BCSPCA S.O.P. or rules and regulations by being summoned to appear for a hearing before a Badge Committee. The findings of the committee will be submitted to the Chief for final adjudication without further hearings or appeal.

Anyone given notice of such meeting and allegations who fails to attend said meeting shall automatically be removed from the Law Enforcement Division.

By signing this document I acknowledge that I have read and understand the requirements for membership in the Burlington County SPCA Law Enforcement Division and that I have received a copy of the BCSPCA By-Laws. I also agree to pay for and have a background check conducted in order to verify my information.
